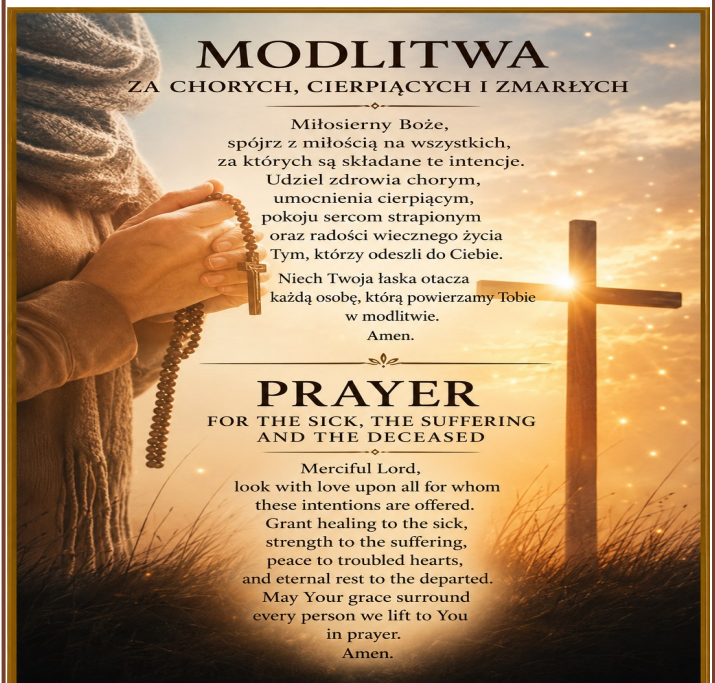

SUNDAY REFLECTIONS

*"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened,
and I will give you rest."*

Today, Jesus reveals two defining characteristics of him: that he knows the Father with all depth and that he is "gentle and humble of heart" (Mt 11:29). We can also discover here two attitudes necessary to understand and live what Jesus offers us: simplicity and the desire to draw near to him.

The wise and learned often find it difficult to enter into the mystery of the Kingdom because they are not open to the newness of divine revelation. God never ceases to reveal himself, but they believe they already know everything and, therefore, God can no longer surprise them. The simple, on the other hand, like children at their best, are receptive, like a sponge absorbing water, capable of surprise and wonder. There are exceptions, of course, and even experts in the humanities can be humble with regard to the knowledge of God.

In the Father, Jesus finds his rest, and his peace can be a refuge for all those who have been worn down by life: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest" (Mt 11:28). Jesus is humble, and humility is the sister of simplicity. When we learn to be happy through simplicity, many complications dissolve, many needs disappear, and at last we can rest.

Jesus invites us to follow him; he does not deceive us: to be with him is to bear his yoke, to accept the demands of love. We will not be spared suffering, but his burden is light, because our suffering will not come from our selfishness, but we will suffer only what is necessary and sufficient, out of love and with the help of the Spirit. Moreover, let us not forget, "the tribulations suffered for God are softened by hope" (St. Ephrem). Evangelinet

SŁOWO NA NIEDZIELE

«Przyjdźcie do Mnie wszyscy, którzy utrudzeni i obciążeni jesteście, a Ja was pokrzepię»

Dzisiaj, Jezus ukazuje nam dwie rzeczywistości, które Go określają: że On jest Tym, który zna Ojca w całej głębi i że On jest «cichy i pokornego serca» (Mt 11,29). Możemy również odkryć w tym dwie postawy niezbędne, by móc zrozumieć i przeżyć to, co Jezus nam oferuje: prostotę i pragnienie zbliżenia się do Niego.

Mądrym i roztroptym często ciężko jest pojąć tajemnicę Królestwa, ponieważ nie są otwarci na nowość objawienia Bożego; Bóg nie przestaje się objawiać, ale oni myślą, że wiedzą już wszystko i z tego powodu Bóg nie może ich już zaskoczyć. Ludzie prości, w przeciwieństwie do nich, są jak dzieci w swoich najlepszych latach, są wrażliwi, są jak gąbka, która chłonie wodę, mają zdolność zdumiewania się i podziwu. Są również wyjątki i są także eksperci w ludzkiej nauce, którzy potrafią być pokorni względem tego, co odnosi się do poznania Boga.

W Ojcu, Jezus znajduje swój odpoczynek i Jego pokój może być schronieniem dla wszystkich tych, którzy zostali skrzywdzeni przez życie: «Przyjdźcie do mnie wszyscy, którzy utrudzeni i obciążeni jesteście, a ja was pokrzepię» (Mt 11,28). Jezus jest pokorny, a pokora jest siostrą prostoty. Kiedy uczymy się bycia szczęśliwymi poprzez prostotę, wiele komplikacji się rozwiązuje, wiele potrzeb znika i w końcu możemy odpocząć. Jezus zaprasza nas do podążania za nim; nie oszukuje nas: bycie z Nim jest dźwiganiem swojego brzemienia, wzięciem na siebie wymagań, które stawia miłość. Nie będzie nam oszczędzone cierpienie, ale jego ciężar jest lekki, bo nasz ból nie będzie przez nas pojmowany egoistycznie, tylko będziemy cierpieć tyle, ile jest to konieczne i przezwycięzymy to przez miłość i z pomocą Ducha. Poza tym, nie zapominajmy, że «przeciwności, które cierpi się dla Boga złagodzone są nadzieją » (św. Efrem).

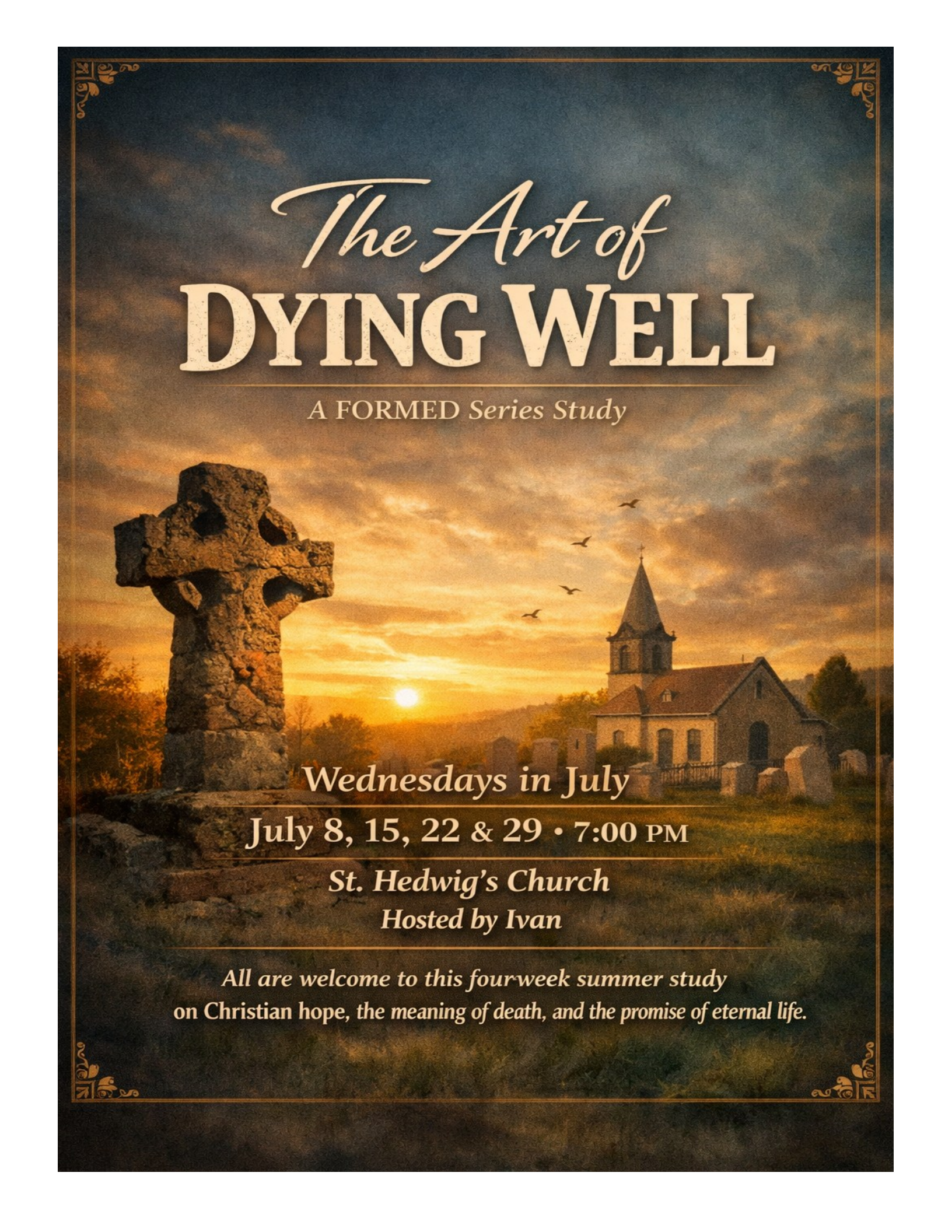

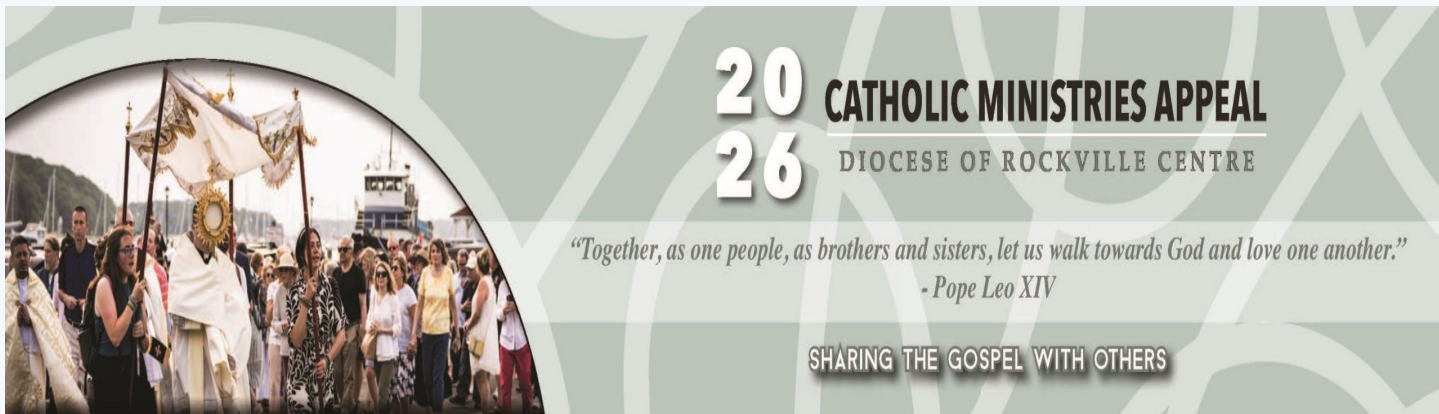

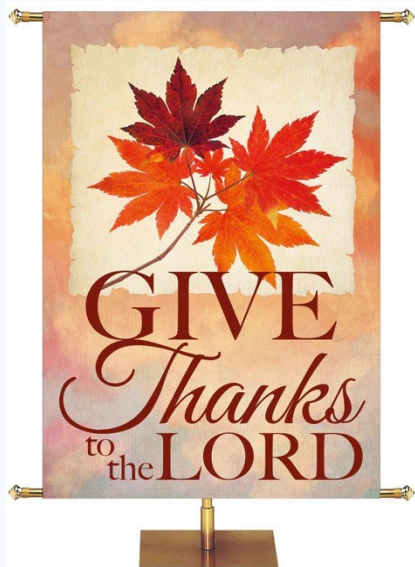

THE ART OF DYING WELL

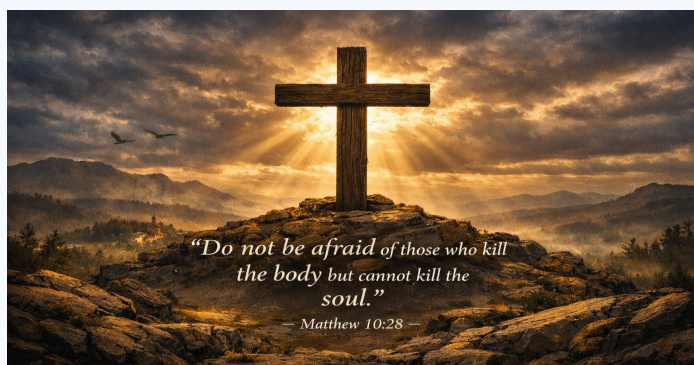

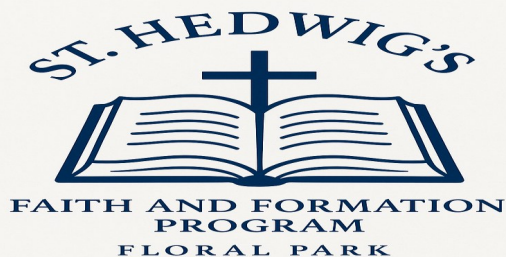
Episode 1: The Story of Death: Discusses the origin of death, what it means for the human person, and how Christ defeated it through His death and resurrection.
